That's the day hundreds of canines will descend on a new waterfront park, just around from the Anzac Bridge, for a pooch party with a difference.

The 'Dog's Breakfast' is being hosted by Lend Lease at its Jacksons Landing Development, Sydney's most pet-friendly residential community, from 10am to 3pm.

The free event will be headlined by:

- Australia's best-known vet **Dr Harry Cooper**, who will provide consultations and demonstrations
- Animal communicator **Simonne Lee**, who uses telepathy to exchange thoughts and emotions with dogs
- Canine cookery expert **Jamie Young**, who will prepare a pasta meal from his book 'Grrrrrowlicious Food for Hungry Dogs', and

There will also be dogachinos and eat-treats which are sure to be woofed-down.

Owners won't miss out, with a barbecue . . . and Dagwood Dogs and Pluto Pups are on the menu. There'll also be refreshments, giveaways and a chance to win some major prizes.

Everyone is invited, however all dogs must be on leads.

The event will take place at the brand new waterfront park, which is on the corner of Bowman Street and refinery Drive within Jacksons Landing. It has special doggy-do bins, a terraced amphitheatre, native trees and shrubs, picnic tables, children's play equipment and amenities. The park is the latest link in a chain of waterfront access to Sydney Harbour, which will eventually stretch from Glebe to Garden Island.

"Jacksons Landing has attracted a lot of pet-lovers because there is plenty of space to exercise animals, and it's right on Sydney's harbourfront, close to Sydney's finest entertainment facilities," said Justin Woodcock, Project Director for Jacksons Landing. "They particularly like the welcoming attitude we have to pets, which sets us apart from most other residential communities."

Residents have even formed their own group, the 'Pyrmont Pooch Party', which meets regularly in Cadi Park – another of the open spaces within Jacksons Landing. When completed in 2012, its 11.7-hectares will include 1,350 apartments and terraces, warehouse conversions and 25,000m<sup>2</sup> of commercial space.
